Director's report - Kelsey Pruitt

- 1) Vending machines. Found out from Coke that a case is 24 units. If we sell at least 30 cases in a year, Coke will leave the machine. On a motion by Mammoser with a second by Fritz, board decided to give it a try.
- The ILA conference is coming up in October. Director would like to attend and has found it valuable in the past. Board approved to send Kelsey on a motion by Singer, second by Yoder.
- 3) Two choices on air conditioning in meeting room. Cost to repair would be \$1,893; to fix would be \$7,781. On a motion by Fritz, second by Mammoser, it was decided to replace the ac unit.

- 5) Summer Reading. Twenty readers completed their assigned 20 hours which is up 8 readers from last year. Water game day in particular was a big hit and will be repeated next year.
